Wu: Awaken, Comprehend, Realize

(In Japanese Kanji this is “Sato”, the first character of Satori)

Interpretation ~

One is truly Awake when the senses are clear,
and the Heart/Mind naturally leads the way .

The Images ~

On the left, 心 *Xin* - Heart, Mind (an abbreviated form of 心 - Heart)

On the right, the compound image 吾 *Wu*- I, me, we, us. This image is composed of 五 *Wu* - Five & 口 *Kou* - Mouth. These can be seen as the five senses (mouths, openings), the Five Spirits, and the opening of the Five Elements, one's entire being within Five Element Theory.
